

Closure of the Meguro Financial Center

Dear Customer,

We regret to notify you that the Meguro Financial Center will close on Tuesday, January 31, 2012. We thank you for your long patronage of this branch. Any of the Shinsei Financial Centers will welcome your future business.

No changes will occur to the cash card, branch code, and account number you use. However, the branch name will become “メグロ” in *katakana* effective Wednesday, February 1, 2012 instead of “目黒” in *kanji*. This is for the Bank’s internal operation purpose, so the Meguro branch does not exist. Please note that the branch name of “Meguro” or “メグロ” is specified for fund transfers to your account from Wednesday, February 1, 2012. For more detailed information and specific requests that need to be carried out for the branch name change, please see the reverse of this letter. “Meguro” in roman letters continue to be a valid option.

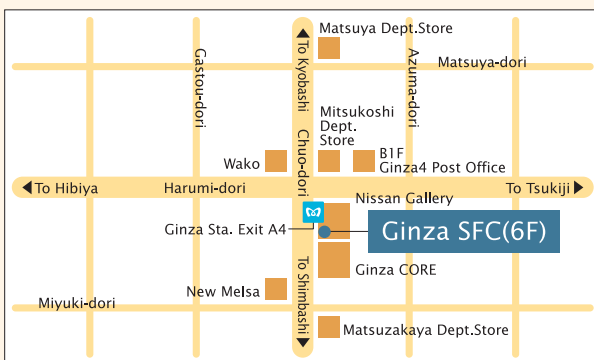
We apologize for any inconvenience it may cause you.

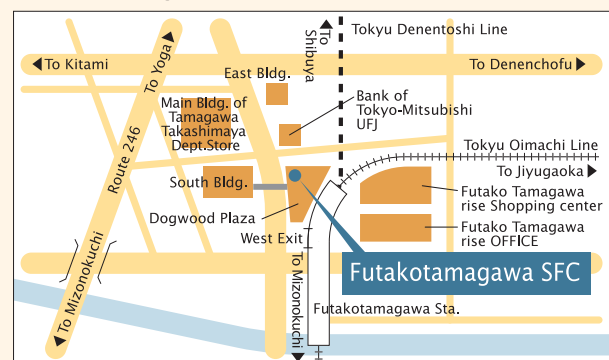

Branch name, branch code, and account number

The branch name will become “メグロ” effective Wednesday, February 1, 2012
The branch code remains 590.
The account number remains the same.

Receiving fund transfers

Please inform possible fund senders of the new branch name, “メグロ”, which becomes effective Wednesday, February 1, 2012, in order for the funds to arrive at the account successfully.

Salary transfer

Customers who receive their salary in the accounts with the Meguro branch are requested to ask their company to change the branch name to “メグロ” after Wednesday, February 1, 2012.

Fund transfers from overseas and domestic fund transfers in foreign currencies

The address of the Meguro Financial Center, which is noted below, will be specified when the funds from overseas or foreign currencies from other domestic financial institutions are transferred to the accounts with the Meguro branch from Wednesday, February 1, 2012.
