Shinsei Bank Opens Shibuya Financial Center

– Opening the Shibuya Financial Center as a core branch in the Jonan district in Tokyo and closing the Roppongi Hills Financial Center and the Jiyugaoka Consulting Spot in order to improve branch efficiency in the neighboring areas –


Tokyo (Friday, October 9, 2015) --- Shinsei Bank, Limited (hereinafter, “Shinsei Bank,” the “Bank”) announced today that the Bank will open the “Shibuya Financial Center” (Shibuya-ku, Tokyo) on Monday, January 18, 2016 in order to strengthen its branch marketing structure in the Jonan district in Tokyo. In conjunction with this opening, the Bank will close the Roppongi Hills Financial Center (Minato-ku, Tokyo) and the Jiyugaoka Consulting Spot (Meguro-ku, Tokyo) as of Wednesday, December 20, 2015 in order to improve branch efficiency in the neighboring areas.

At the Shibuya Financial Center, highly trained staff members will offer asset management consulting services and recommend financial products that are most suitable to customers’ needs and life plans. The Shibuya Financial Center will be open weekdays between the hours of 09:00 and 17:00 excluding national holidays.

Since the closing the former Shibuya Financial Center in July 2010 due to changes in the area around the Financial Center, Shinsei Bank had looked into candidate sites for a new branch in the Shibuya-ku area of Tokyo in order to develop a branch network in the Jonan district of Tokyo. The Bank will now open the Shibuya Financial Center in a prime real estate location, located a two minute walk from the east exit of Shibuya Station which is undergoing large-scale redevelopment and is expected to attract more commercial facilities around it. With the opening of the Shibuya Financial Center, Shinsei Bank aims to improve the convenience of its branches for our existing customers as well as acquire new customers, in order to further strengthen the Bank’s individual business in the Jonan district.
